ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The curriculum is designed to enable students to perform a variety of duties, as well as provide technical support to the surgical team in the operating room before, during and after surgery. The Central Service Technician is responsible for the procurement of surgical supplies and equipment. Central Service Technicians provide support to all patient care services in the health care facility. They are responsible for decontaminating, cleaning, processing, assembly, sterilizing, storing and distributing the medical supplies needed in patient care, especially during surgery.



With the ever-expanding technological advancements in medical supplies, instrumentation, medical devices and equipment, highly trained individuals are needed in the field of central service. Central service technicians are trained in principles, methods and control of sterilization processes; and the cleaning, processing, packaging, distributing, storing and inventory control of sterile supply, instruments, trays and equipment.

WHAT DO SURGICAL TECHNOLOGY CENTRAL SERVICE TECHNICIANS DO?

Central Service Technicians (also known as Medical Equipment Preparers) prepare, sterilize, install, or clean laboratory or healthcare equipment. Central Service Technicians may also perform routine laboratory tasks and operate or inspect equipment.

WHERE DO THEY WORK?

Central Service Technicians work in general medical and surgical hospitals, dentist offices, outpatient care centers, physician offices, and colleges, universities, and professional schools.


